## **Next meeting of the ANGELS project:**

### **The infectious risk in the center of the debates.**

ANGELS project (Augmented reality Network GEnenerating Learning on Safety), is a training system for education and learning on safety and health at work, particularly in the hospital environment. ANGELS uses the augmented reality (computer system that can superimpose 3D image on a real image to combine real and virtual).

This project is run by the University Hospital « Fondazione PTV Policlinico Tor Vergata » in Rome, Italy, and the consortium also includes the Management and Human Resources company MF & PARTNERS CONSULTING, the Italian Human Resources and Development firm Entropy KN, the Italian computer company Inglobe Technology (IT), the training center in paramedical care NCONZO in Brno, Czech Republic, and the applied psychology, clinical psychology and biopsychology department of the Spain university of Jaume 1 in Castellon, near Valencia.
